California State University, Fresno Facility and Academic Program Improvement Initiative Measure - Shall the measure expanding access in nursing, agriculture, criminology, science, engineering, other fields; repairing/upgrading campus facilities; providing safe drinking water; making campus more accessible for people with disabilities; providing scholarships for local students, veterans, by establishing a countywide 1/4 cent sales tax, except in jurisdictions where the tax exceeds the combined rate limit, providing approximately \$63,000,000 annually for 25 years with audits, public spending disclosure, be adopted?

Measure 1 Support – Vote YES

AUTHORIZES \$6.38 BILLION IN BONDS TO BUILD MENTAL HEALTH TREATMENT FACILITIES FOR THOSE WITH MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE USE CHALLENGES; PROVIDES HOUSING FOR THE HOMELESS, LEGISLATIVE STATUTE. Amends Mental Health Services Act to provide additional behavioral health services. Fiscal Impact: Shift roughly \$140 million annually of existing tax revenue for mental health, drug, and alcohol treatment from counties to the state. Increased state bond repayment costs of \$310 million annually for 30 years.
