FRESNO, CA – Councilmember Esmeralda Soria, Assemblymember Dr. Joaquin Arambula, and SCCC Trustee Annalisa Perea are hosting a FREE District 1 Community Health Day event in partnership with USCF’s Mobile Heal and Neighborhood Industries’ Fresno Cares food distribution program to provide No-Cost COVID-19 Testing, Free Flu Shots, and a Turkey with groceries for Fresno families for this holiday season.

Due to the impacts of COVID-19 our community’s food insecurity has grown. This holiday season will be particularly difficult for many local families. CARES Act funding through the City of Fresno has allowed programs such as the Fresno Cares and UCSF Mobile Heal to provide much needed resources to our most vulnerable residents such as our seniors and those recommended to shelter in place.
